The 'O Antiphons' are said on the seven days preceding Christmas Eve (17-23 December).

December 17: Wednesday Mass at 9 am

O Sapientia [O Wisdom]

O Wisdom of our God Most High, guiding creation with power and love: come to teach us the path of knowledge!

December 18: Thursday Mass at 9 am

O Adonai [O Lord and Ruler]

O Leader of the House of Israel, giver of the Law to Moses on Sinai: come to rescue us with your mighty power!

December 19: Friday Mass at 9 am

O Radix Jesse [O Root of Jesse]

O Root of Jesse's stem, sign of God's love for all his people: come to save us without delay!

December 20: Saturday Mass at 5.30 pm

O Clavis David [O Key of David]

O Key of David, opening the gates of God's eternal Kingdom: come and free the prisoners of darkness!

December 21: Sunday Mass at 11 am

O Oriens [O Rising Dawn or Morning Star]

O Radiant Dawn, splendour of eternal light, sun of justice: come and shine on those who dwell in darkness and in the shadow of death.

December 22: Monday Mass at 9 am

O Rex Gentium [O King of the Nations]

O King of all na7ons and keystone of the Church: come and save man, whom you formed from the dust!

December 23: Tuesday Mass at 9 am

O Emmanuel

- Walk in small groups or in pairs, preferably with someone you have not spoken to before, chatting, rambling, getting to know each other better.
- The Route will start at the Church at 10 am, going through High Tree Estate and into Brockwell Park through the Cressingham Garden entrance. From here, we will loop around the park, passing by the pond and Brockwell Hall. At Brockwell Park we say for the Rosary.
- After the Rosary, we gathered for a relaxed refreshment with Shobha and Joseph as our hosts near Norwood Lodge, enjoying mulled wine, soft drinks, and some baked goods before heading back to the Church via Brockwell Park Garden and Trinity Rise.
- The walk ends with a closing Prayer and a blessing in the Church.

An Advent Fundraising Cake Sale Project

Dear fellow Parishioners,

We would like to invite you to take part in our Advent Fundraising Project.

We are Edward Cassin (4th yr Senior) and Jack Cassin (2nd yr Senior), and we both attend the London Oratory School in West Brompton, a state secondary school. We intend to support our form house Advent Fundraising Project by praying for the victims of crime, and working toward the rehabilitation of those in prison to reduce their reoffending. One small way we would like to do this is to offer kindness this Christmas to men in prison who practice the Catholic Faith. We believe such acts of kindness can inspire them in their transformation.

This Advent, our form house has received special dispensation to raise money for the Catholic chaplaincy of HMP Wandsworth. One of our form teachers, who has been volunteering in the prison chaplaincy with Catholics for several years, noted that this year the chaplaincy is in particular need of support to carry out its good work of rehabilitating prisoners through Faith. Monies raised are going towards a Christmas gift bag for prisoners who

practice the Catholic Faith, including sachets of coffee and chocolate, a Christmas card, and a pair of socks. We have set a target to cover the costs of the items to go inside the bag. We both feel passionate about giving back and would like to organise a cake sale next Sunday, 21st December, after the Mass, to support this fundraising. All proceeds will go to this worthy cause.
